You need to complete 240 credit points including:

- 40 credit points BA Core
- 80 credit points Education Studies - Primary Teaching Specialisation Major
- 80 credit points Arts Major
- 40 credit points Electives

At The College you complete 40 credit points in the BA Core and 40 credit points of Electives.

You need to choose an Education Studies Major - Primary Teaching Specialisation from English, Maths or Science.

You also need to choose an Arts Major from the list in the Handbook.
