## REVIEW OF GRADE

If you believe that there is an error with your mark or grade, you should speak with your Unit Coordinator about it. If you are unable to resolve it with your Unit Coordinator you can apply for a Review of Grade.

If you need to lodge a Review of Grade application you must do this within 10 business days of your results being available in MySR. ## PROGRESSION – STAYING ON TRACK WITH YOUR STUDY
