

Scaffolded/Chunked Learning

What is Scaffolded Learning

- Lessons broken up into chunks that increase in complexity
- Decreases cognitive load
- Stepping students through the learning process
- Connecting ideas between chunks assists the learning process
- Builds student confidence





What is H5P?



IT'S HTML 5

The name H5P is short for HTML 5 Package.

You will look like a coding wizard without having to do any coding. **THE PROCESS**

You create H5P content in vUWS, then insert or embed it into your vUWS site. Inserting or Embedding each have different functionality when it comes to student grading.

WHY USE IT?

H5P allows you to create content that is engaging, interactive. Used properly it can enhance student learning experience and progress students' skills from knowledge to synthesis and evaluation.




