

ICS Teaching Resources

This document is an inventory of 50 Teaching Resources produced by researchers at the Institute for Culture and Society at Western Sydney University. The inventory is focused upon digital material (e.g. documentary films, video lectures, interactive websites, podcasts and online manuals) that students and others may access independently as part of online teaching.

The materials include our Key Thinkers and Concept Lecture Series as well as outcomes emerging from projects funded by the Australian Research Council and other funding agencies.
