## INDIGENOUS NATIONALS BOND AGREEMENT

For all representative sport events ("**Events**") at Western Sydney University ("**University**"), a refundable bond will be a part of the costs associated with a student's ("**Participant**") participation in the **Event** in an effort to minimise anti-social and inappropriate behaviour at these **Events** and to enhance the overall experience for all students involved.

The policy places emphasis on self-regulation and personal responsibility as well as highlighting the importance of a positive, supportive and unified team culture.

For all **Events**, **Participant's** will be charged a refundable bond. This bond will be refunded to the **Participant** at the conclusion of the relevant **Event** provided that the **Participant** has not breached the following ("**Participant Obligations**"):

- 1. Table 1 of this agreement and
- 2. Indigenous Nationals Participation Agreement and,
- 3. All relevant University rules, policies, procedures and guidelines

**Participants** will be notified as soon as reasonably practicable upon the decision being made that the **Participant's** bond has been forfeited.

Any subsequent breaches of the **Participant Obligations** will result in the immediate expulsion of the **Participant** from the **Event**, the **Participant** being sent home at their own cost, the **Participant** not being considered for future team selection and the matter being referred to the Western Sydney University non-academic misconduct unit for review.

All bond refund decisions are at the sole discretion of the **University** on a case-bycase basis. If a **Participant** feels that a bond refund decision is unfair, they may request a meeting with the Director, Badanami Centre for Indigenous Education to discuss their case.

**Participant** must adhere to the required conduct set out within below which outlines what a **Participant** must do to get their bond back and what actions will result in the loss of the bond.

The following do's and don'ts list is meant to be a guide that Participants may use to ensure that they retain their bond. It is not a definitive list and may not contain certain behaviours or actions that would still result in the forfeiture of the bond due to a breach of the Participation Obligations.

## DO'S

- Comply with Indigenous Nationals Participation Agreement
- Treat everyone equally and with respect at all times
- Keep the area at sports venues clean and tidy
- Keep rooms and accommodation common areas clean and tidy
- Follow all rules that are outlined by the accommodation providers
- Keep noise to a minimum after set curfews (Repeated warnings will result in loss of bond)

- Be responsible for one's actions as you are adults and should act accordingly
- Show fantastic sportsmanship on and off the field, no abusing officials or opposition competitors, staff or spectators
- To report any damages to rooms or common areas immediately so they can be handled in a timely and cost-effective manner
- Be in an appropriate physical condition to compete at all times
- Always compete to the best of your ability, i.e. no "throwing games"/noncompetitive acts such as snakes and ladders
- Return any equipment or uniforms that have been asked for at the conclusion of the **Event**
- Attend team meetings and team organised events

## DON'T

- Breach Indigenous Nationals Participation Agreement
- Do anything illegal
- Consume an excessive amount of alcohol which leads to third-party or medical assistance being required
- Peer pressure students to do tasks they do not want to do
- Bully, isolate and intimidate other students, staff member or any other persons either in person or via online platforms such as Social Media.
- Organise and participate in Kangaroo Court
- Be disrespectful to fellow students, staff members or any other persons
- Consume alcohol at any sporting events during the competition
- Damage accommodation property without reporting it
- Misuse accommodation facilities
- Participate in any action that could be considered public nuisance or bring the University's name into disrepute.
